PG&E appreciates the opportunity to provide comments in response to PRR 1114 (*Outage coordination changes due to reliability coordinator service*):

1. Section 3.2 Outage States → PG&E recommends to add verbiage surrounding the assessment of Planned Outage Substitution Obligation to the description of the “Approve” and “Denied” states.
  - i. An outage is “approved” when it is accepted by ISO. **For resources with an RA obligation, CAISO has determined No Planned Outage Substitution Obligation (POSO).**
  - ii. An outage is “denied” when it is not accepted by the ISO **due to System Reliability. For resources with an RA obligation, CAISO has identified that substitution requirements were not met via Planned Outage Substitution Obligation (POSO).**
2. Section 8.7.2 Outages Cancelled/Disapproved → section needs modification as the ISO state of “Disapproved” is being revised to “Denied”.
